II. State of Emergency Proclamation

- On or around 10:30 a.m. on March 19, 2020 Mayor Devenny signed a State of Emergency Proclamation declaring the existence of an emergency threatening the lives, safety, health, and welfare of the people within the City.
- §15-9(4) of the City Code states that the City Council shall be called into session within 24 hours after a state of emergency has been proclaimed by the Mayor.
- This Emergency Session is to update the Council on the actions taken and answer any questions.
- Council Members may attend this meetings by electronic media.

III. Adjournment

*§ 30-4-80(a) of the South Carolina Codes of Laws states in part that the 24 hours meeting notice requirement does not apply to emergency meetings of public bodies.
