The Red Rose Festival is in its 16th year located in the Cultural Arts District of Historic Downtown Lancaster, SC. In 2022 we had over 25,000 visitors come to the festival. We hope to have you at our festival this coming spring. We will kick off the event on Friday, May 19, 2023, at 6 PM with live entertainment and close at 10:30 PM. We continue the fun festivities on Saturday, May 20, 2023, at 10 AM and close the festival at 10 PM. We do have a "Red Rose Theme", this year it is "Paint the Town Red" we encourage your booth to be decorated in this theme. There will be a competition for the best vendor, "Use of Theme."

You will be contacted by the Event and Promotions Manager, Lisa Roddey, if you are selected to be a vendor at this year's festival. Emphasis will be placed on vendors that offer a range in their merchandise.

Red Rose Festival Guidelines: Please read all guidelines carefully some have changed:

This is a Rain or Shine Event or Heat. Be responsible and tie your tents down securely. Please be aware that the event will be located on the street and that The City of Lancaster is not responsible for tying your tents. Please bring weights to secure your items. Please be aware that the event site is on concrete and not completely level.

Vendors are 100% self-contained. The City of Lancaster absolutely will not provide: ice, water, electricity, rentals, tables, chairs, and/or lighting. The Vendor must supply their own QUIET GENERATOR quite generators are considered to measure less than 60 dB on a noise level meter. The City of Lancaster will measure any generator that is suspect not to meet requirements. If your generator does not meet the requirement of what is considered a "quiet generator" you will be asked to not use the generator or leave. The City of Lancaster will not supply or "go get" fuel. Please plan accordingly.

Vendors are not allowed to leave their booth unattended during festival hours. Saturday, May 20, 2023, Setup @ 7:00 AM, Festival for Vendors 10AM-7 PM.

Trash: Vendors are responsible for disposing of their own waste products including grease, trash, oil and ice. We will provide a large trash bag along with two large dumpsters at each end of the street during the festival. DO NOT dispose of any food or liquid on the ground or drains. DO NOT use the any trash receptacles that does not indicate useable for festival. TAKE all liquid, food and oil products with you. Anyone caught emptying trash, food, or oil in private trash containers will be disbarred from attending future festivals. You may also be ticketed for illegal dumping.

All vendors are expected to conduct themselves in a professional and courteous manner when interacting with festival goers, fellow vendors and festival organizers. Aggressive and inappropriate conduct and/or contact with festival goers will result in immediate removal from the festival.

Prices should be easily seen and prices legible in a visible space. Only family friendly items will be allowed to be sold. The Event Staff reserves the right to request removal of any items from the booth that are not family friendly.

Each Vendor is responsible for reporting to the South Carolina Department of Revenue and retaining a South Carolina Department of Revenue Business License. Each vendor will also be responsible for 2% Hospitality Tax payable to the City of Lancaster.

Vendors must take all items with them. The City of Lancaster is not responsible for items left behind. You will need to enter Main St from W Arch St.

ALL Non-profits must have some sign about their purpose of raising funds. Vendors are responsible for handling their own currency as well as collecting and reporting South Carolina sales tax. You must have enough cash to make your own change. At the end of the festival if you need an escort to your vehicle due to amount of money, please request the City of Lancaster Police.

Vendors will not be allowed to breakdown and physically leave the festival area prior to closing time. This applies to all vendors including Civic, Church and non-profits.
