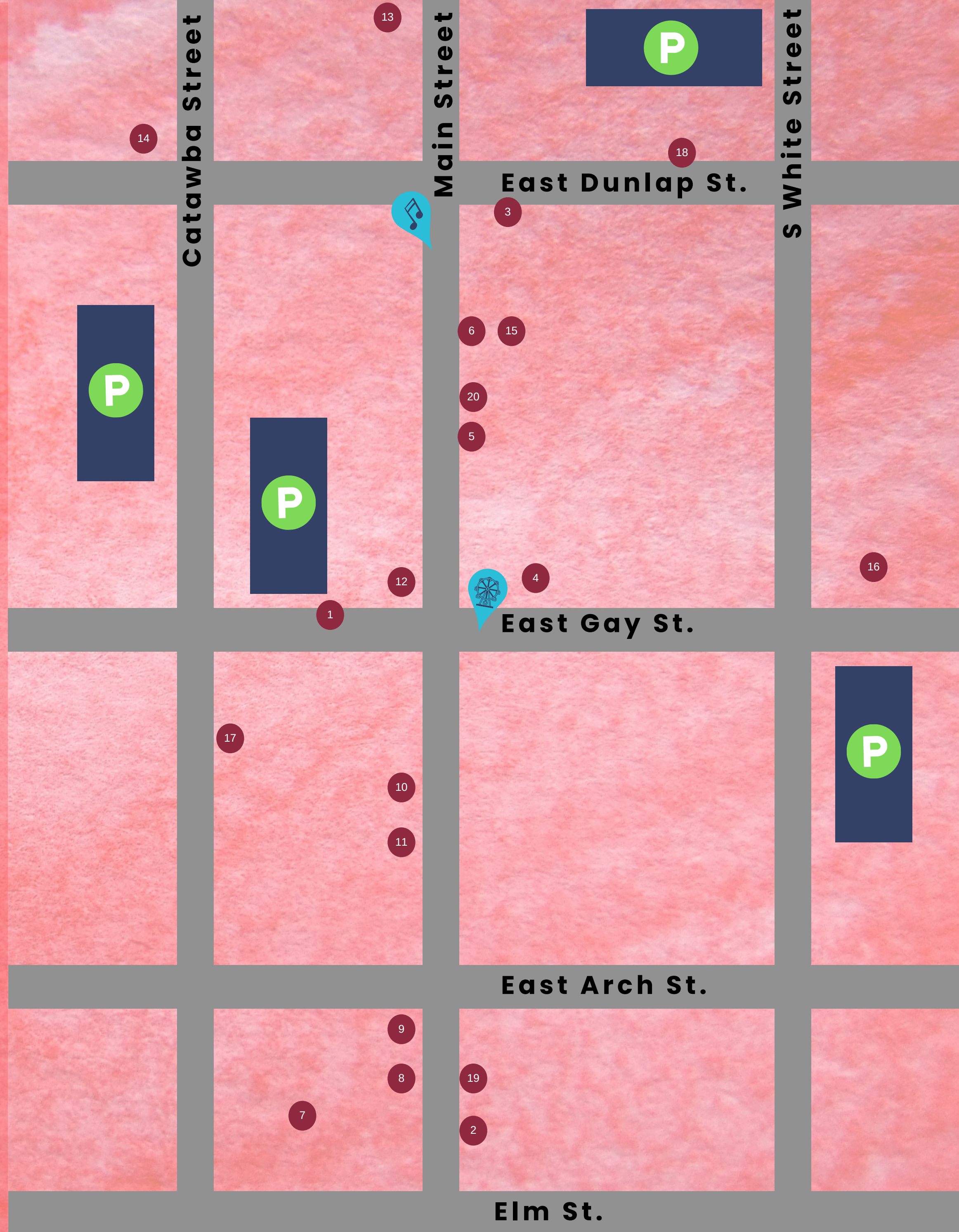
Downtown Shopping Map
